

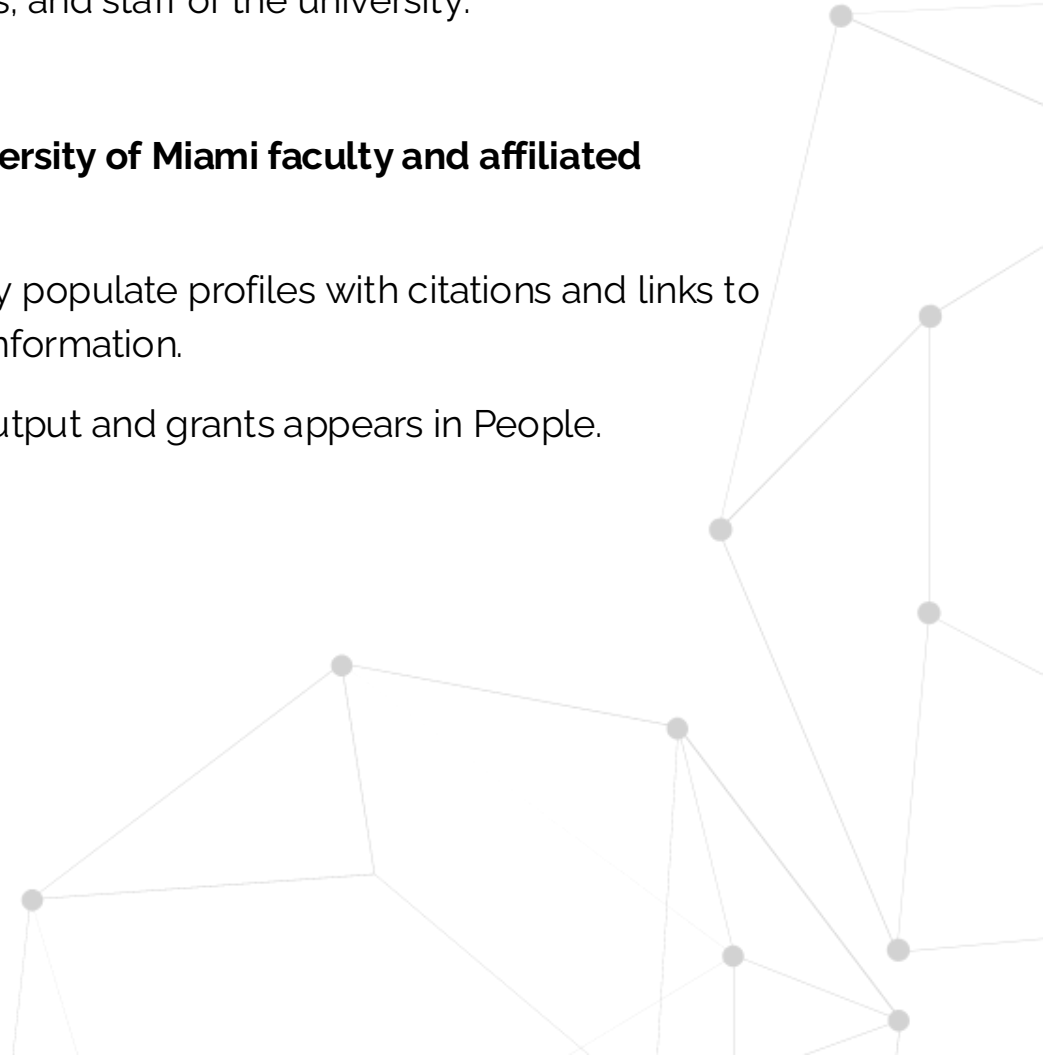

DOAJ works to increase the visibility, accessibility, reputation, usage and impact of quality, peer-reviewed, open access scholarly research journals.
